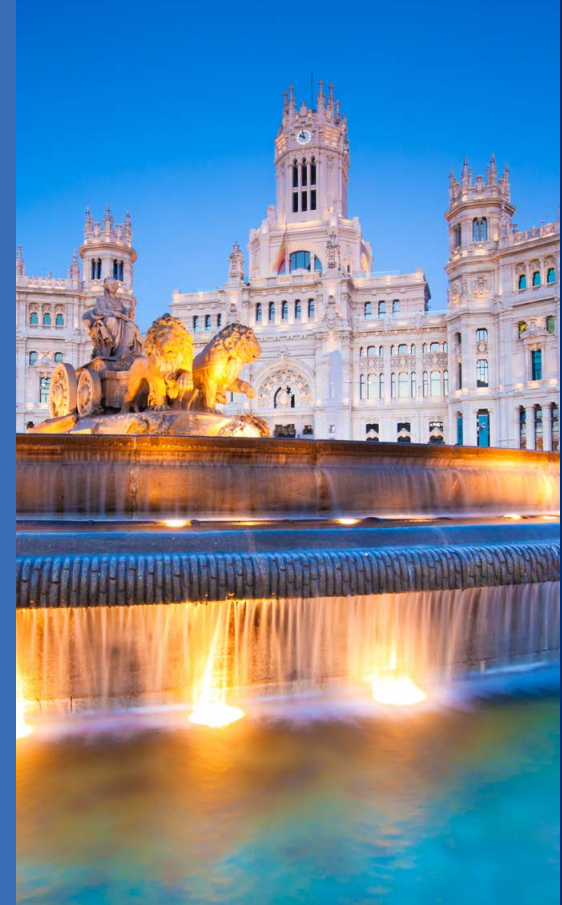

Evening meal in local restaurant followed by stroll to Puerta del Sol

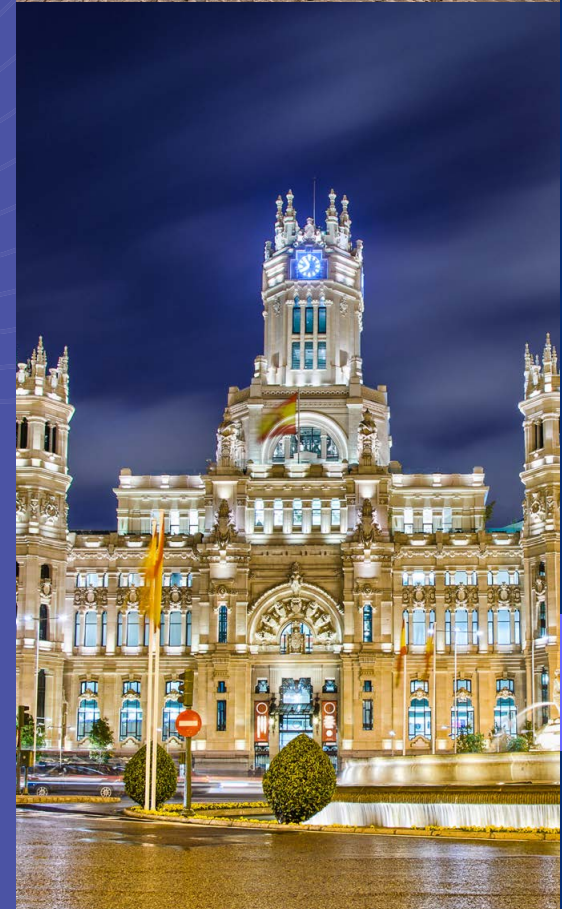

Visit to Plaza de Cibeles

The Plaza de Cibeles is a beautiful, grand square with a neo-classical complex of marble sculptures with fountains that has become an iconic symbol for the city of Madrid. The Cibeles Fountain shows Cybele, the Greek goddess of fertility and nature holding a sceptre and a key while being pulled by two lions on a chariot. The pull of the wild lions symbolizes the power of nature or of the goddess. Whenever the local football team Real Madrid wins a cup, fans flock around the fountain to celebrate.
